If you have a generator, make sure it is working. Not just running the motor but verifying that it runs a light or a fan. If the motor runs but the light or fan do not, it is possible that the generator part needs to be re-magnetized. Shut the engine down, plug in a drill motor to one of the ac outlets and turn the motor head (chuck) backwards a few times. Then start the motor and try running the drill. Also, the Sun Herald and WLOX pass out hurricane preparedness pamphlets that give you a good idea what you might need to ride out a storm. Check their websites. Hopefully we won't need to worry about it this year.

Sunday afternoons downstairs by the pool are becoming a popular hangout this year. There will be hot dogs, burgers and frozen margaritas served from one until six. Come by and relax with friends. I hope to see you soon at the club.


